<i>Scope / Objective of the scheme including major interventions</i>	The main objective of the project is to promote indigenous art and crafts and preserve the works of art viz., pottery & glazed tiles work.

Decision

- a) The scheme was approved in Principle with changed nomenclature viz: “Establishment of Sindh Kashi Institute at Bhitshah and Conservation and Restoration of Dabgeer Mosque Thatta” which is classic example of Fine Kashi works which need to be restored.
- b) Provision proposed for training to the foreign countries would be changed to hire experts / persons from aboard.
- c) Vehicle provision proposed for Dabgeer Mosque would be deleted and provision proposed for revenue component would be minimized.
- d) Provision of one vehicle Suzuki jeep for Kashi Institute would be kept.
- e) A management board comprising of Mr. Abdul Hameed Akhund, Member Executive Committee Mohata Place, Chairman Fine Arts Department Sindh University, Dr. Kaleemullah Lashari, Secretary Antiquities, Mr. Shams Jaffrani, Secretary Culture & Tourism Deptt., Mr. Hakim Ali Shah Bhukhari, Mr. Kazi Khizar Hayat, Sikandar Arts Gallery, Nawabshah for management and monitoring of the institution . The committee may coopt any other member / members particularly from corporate sector.
- f) Prestigious institution like Mehran University or Sindh University, Indus Valley, Fine art Department or any other quality institution from private sector to be involved in the establishment of Institution.
- g) For Dabgeer Mosque, Antiquities Department may be involved.
- h) The sponsors would modify PC-I in light of above discussions and observations raised in the working paper and the same be forwarded to the P&D Department.
- i) Advice for A.A would be issued on receipt of modified PC-I from the Culture & Tourism Department and its final clearance by the chairman PDWP/Additional Chief Secretary (Dev)
