

## **SCHEME OF ENVIRONMENT SECTOR APPROVED BY PDWP ON 16-10-2008**

<b><i>Name of Scheme</i></b>	Procurement of 54 Fire Tenders for Taluka Municipal Administration (TMAs) in Sindh except Karachi (ADP # 1534) 2008-09

<b>Scope / Objective of the scheme including major interventions</b>	The objective of the project is to provide immediate technical support to TMAs in Sindh by providing 54 fire tender vehicles to strengthen the municipal services of firefighting. The project is designed to improve the firefighting activities in the TMA jurisdiction in order to save and protect the human life and property of people residing in TMA during fire incidents.

### **Decision**

- The scheme was approved at a cost of Rs.324.00 million.
- The advice for administrative approval would be issued by Development Section, P&D Department.
- The nomenclature of scheme would be for procurement of 54 fire tenders instead of 58 fire tenders.
- Local Government Department would get written consent of all TMAs to bear the recurring liabilities including maintenance and operation of fire tenders and providing technical staff and Drivers as well as availability of parking areas and provide copies to P&D Department and Finance Department.
- A.D would submit the corrected copies of PC-I in the light of above discussions and points raised in the working paper to Planning & Development Department and Finance Department for record.
- All the required codal formalities and procedures as per PEPRA rules would be observed by A.D.
- Local Government Department would provide the detailed status report of fire strike vehicles (103), tractors (4x4) with front end loader (99), refuse van (ARM Roll Type) with 8 Nos. detachable containers of earlier scheme costing Rs.559.351 million which was approved by PDWP on 20-02-2007. The status of funds utilized and unutilized like funds specified for third party validation etc would also be provided.
- Local Government would submit PC-IV i.e. completion report of earlier scheme namely "Procurement of Fire Fighting and Solid Waste Machinery for All Taluka Municipal Administrations (TMAs) Sindh province except Karachi" costing Rs.559.351 million on the proper format designed by the Planning Commission to Planning & Development Department.

<b>Scope / Objective of the scheme including major interventions</b>	Basically the proposal is envisaged to initiate the comprehensive assessment and prioritize the environmental issues in Sindh which will help to prepare viable action plans as to minimize the environmental effects and reduce its further degradation with the following specific objectives : (i) Estimating the costs of environmental degradation. (ii) Perceptions of environmental degradation. (iii) Institutional analysis (iv) Recommendation to address environmental issues. (v) Environmental problems due to rural sugar industries and cement factories. (vi) Costal management. (vii) Hospital and municipal solid waste. (viii) Municipal waste water. (ix) Water pollution.

## **Decision**

- i. The scheme PC-II costing Rs.28.00 million (i.e US\$ 350,000/-) was cleared for onward transmission to P&D Division for consideration in the CDWP.
- ii. Development Section would forward required copies of PC-II to P&D Division for consideration / approval through CDWP fore its onward transmission to World Bank authorities through EAD.
