<b>Scope / Objective of the scheme including major interventions</b>	<p>The Population Welfare program activities are mainly financed by the Federal Government. However, the supplementary support by Government of Sindh was continued with an allocation of Rs. 23.623 million for the current financial year.</p> <p>The scope envisaged include continuation of ongoing activities of salaries and operational expenditure of 38 Family Welfare Centres, operational support for the 4<sup>th</sup> Directorate for Communication, Trainings logistics, strengthening of management information system and advocacy activities.</p>

## **Decision**

- (i) The scheme was approved in principle till the period ending June 2010.
- (ii) The Secretary, Population Welfare Department would review and rationalize the physical and financial phasing of the proposed project. Accordingly, the modified PC-I would be furnished to Planning & Development Department for further necessary processing.
- (iii) The additional financial requirement in the current financial year would be provided through intra sectoral re-appropriation.
- (iv) Subsequent to the approval of federally assisted project PC-I and receipt of financial assistance from the Federal Government, the financial assistance from Government of Sindh would be discontinued.
- (v) On receipt and scrutiny of the modified PC-I, the advice for administrative approval would be issued accordingly.

<b><i>Scope / Objective of the scheme</i></b>	The 05 years. Population Welfare Program, Sindh is an integral part of the national Population Welfare Program, which aims to take the family planning services at the doorsteps of the people and to ensure quality of services with the right of choice for small family norm and to achieve population stabilization.
<b><i>Including major interventions</i></b>	<p>The proposed project is to be exclusively financed by the Federal Government and includes support for infrastructure at the Provincial, District, Tehsil/ Taluka level, Regional offices, continuation and additions in Reproductive Health centres, Family Welfare Centres, Mobile service units, Male and Female Social Mobilizers, involvement of Registered medical practitioners, Hakeems, Religious leaders, association with other provincial line departments etc.</p> <p>The Project, duly cleared by PDWP, had been forwarded to the Ministry of Population Welfare for further necessary processing.</p>

### **Decision**

- i. The scheme was cleared for onward transmission to the Federal Government for consideration by CDWP/ ECNEC.
- ii. In the light of above deliberations and the comments communicated with the working paper, the Population Welfare Department, Government of Sindh would pursue the Ministry of Population Welfare for the modifications and or additions essentially required in the prescribed in the PC-I document.
- iii. Further, the availability of funds as per the proposed financial phasing would be ensured from the Federal Government as being exclusive sponsoring agency so that the desired sequence in the required multidimensional interventions was effectively maintained.
