Irrigation & Power Department has initiated the scheme due to complains of the resident of village Sonheri of Taluka Sonada District Thatta due to heavy seepage of Water from Keenjhar Lake, which has created unhygienic conditions and several other problems. To provide immediate relief to the people of the area and protect them from the seepage water & other problems IPD proposed following works to be carried out as remedial measures:

- (i) Construction of seepage channel along Keenjhar Lake for collection of seepage water.
- (ii) Construction of Pump / Sump and Pump house along link road to Sonehri village for dewatering the collected seepage water.
- iii) Construction of link road for link canal to village and extension of VIP Bund Rd 57+7000 to 62+720.
