SALIENT FEATURES OF ADP-2008-09.

- Rs. 150.000 million have been earmarked for nine schemes of Environment and Alternative Energy Department.
- Rs. 30.000 million are for 6 ongoing schemes / studies and Rs. 120.000 million for 3 new schemes.
- One new scheme is for the construction of "Regional offices of EPA at Sukkur, Hyderabad and auditorium of EPA complex at Karachi".
- Other new scheme is regarding "Feasibility Study and then Remedial Measures for restoration of lakes and other water bodies in Sindh".
- New initiative has been taken to start joint partnership programme between Government of Sindh, Civil Society organizations and communities for installation of solar panels, Wind Mills and Biogas plants to provide electricity to the remote areas, installation of Desalination Plants to provide Potable Water and Climate change adaptation technologies to improve the livelihood / living standard of the Poor Communities in the Rural, Mountainous and Aids areas in Sindh.
- Installation of 1108 purification and Reverse Osmosis Plants in all Union Councils of Sindh would be undertaken under the mega project viz "Clean Drinking Water for All"
- More-over 58 fire Tenders would be provided to TMAs in Sindh.
